ADA is committed to ensuring that all workers are compensated appropriately. Accreditation by Ethical Clothing Australia (ECA) ensures that local textiles workers throughout the supply chain receive all their legal minimum entitlements and work in safe conditions.

ADA is proudly the first Australian business to apply for ECA accreditation when the program launched over 20 years ago.

The ECA program maps ADA's Australian supply chain throughout the design, pattern making, cut, make, trim and dispatch, including any value-adding services. This is done via annual third-party compliance audits conducted by the Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) Union. By encouraging companies to view supply chain management as an integral part of business, ECA protects the rights of both local factory-based workers and outworkers (Also known as homeworkers).

ADA is accredited and licensed to display the Ethical Clothing Australia trademark on its Australian made garments.
