## SCOPE OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The ADA factory at 30 McGoldrick Court, East Bendigo has been in operation since the early 1990's, primarily producing uniforms for the Australian Defence Force. Since then, production has expanded to include body armour components, tactical equipment and certified Fire Garments.

Activities performed at this site include the warehousing, cutting of fabric and the manufacture, inspection and repair of garments and equipment. The factory is also serviced by an onsite cafeteria.

ADA's Environmental Management System covers all functions at the East Bendigo facility, including those by onsite contractors, to ensure all compliance obligations are fulfilled.

In order to achieve this, ADA will consider internal and external issues, relevant compliance obligations, and implement practices to minimise risk in the activities it has authority and ability to control and influence.
